



Nurse - Job Description

Lowell Youth Leadership Program's mission is to connect and engage Lowell youth by empowering them to develop vital life skills and encourage them to lead and thrive through cooperation with each other. LYLP organizational growth will be anchored in our guiding principles and will be used to strengthen our children's relationships within our community.

LYLP's immediate goal is to serve Lowell youth ages 10-16 by hosting a free two-week summer day program at the Greater Lowell Technical High School from June 26th to July 21st, 2023. The program will combine life skill instruction with a variety of sports activities.

General Responsibilities

To provide leadership, guidance, and safety to participants through high quality enjoyable experiences

Qualifications -

- Must be board certified RN in state of MA
- Must have 2 years of Nursing experience
- CPR and First Aid
- Knowledge of use of an AED
- Must be creative, energetic, and patient
- Have the ability to positively motivate the participants and other staff members
- Be willing to work with youth of all abilities and of diverse backgrounds
- Exemplify positive leadership characteristics
- Ability to pass a background check, a physical, and proof of immunizations
- Must make a commitment to be available weekdays from June 26 - July 21 (with the exception for July 4) from 7am - 2pm daily

Specific Duties (Nurse)

- Maintain the medical well being of the participants, staff and volunteers.
- Maintain accurate records of all incidents that happen during camp hours.
- Dispense daily medications to participants.
- Apply first aid for minor injuries. Give medical attention for sore throats, earaches, stomach aches and rashes.
- Good Communication Skills with parents
- Accompany participants or staff to hospital.
- Collaborate with other medical personnel, as doctors, pharmacy and other health care professionals.
- Other duties as determined by the Program Director
